

Minutes of Eastern Centre Grass Riders Forum (2008 season)
held on Sunday 15 June 2008 at Ugley, 11.30 am

Approximately 20 riders supporters and officials attended the meeting.

Julian Sayer explained the history of the introduction of the Sub Committees and their purpose.

The introduction of a Championship class for upright machines in 2007 had been a success, thanks to Neil Copestake for donating the trophy.

The accident to an Eastern Centre marshall at Wainfleet was mentioned and if anyone had any ideas about making marshalling safer then please let anyone on the Sub Committee aware of the idea.

The 2nd round of the Eastern Centre Championship would take place next Saturday 21 June at Iken, the 3rd round is currently subject to change but it is possible it could be at Fenland on 14 September rather than at High Easter, more details will be announced next week at Iken.

Julian Sayer asked those present if they wished to keep the Championship over 3 rounds or reduce it to a one day event, the vast majority of those present wanted it left as it is.
