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
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The Recollection Section

Sidge Kenny

In the high summer of 1964, I drove my JCB through the famous gates of the genteel coastal town of Frinton-on-sea — which was already having its feathers ruffled by the highly visible sight of Radio Caroline moored just a few miles off



shore. My mission was to clear the garden of a large property to make way for an additional building plot – something which was to happen much more in Frinton as the years passed. At our morning tea-break, I sat on the low garden wall out in the warm sun with an elderly man who was the gardener of the house and was, in effect, working to terminate his job. Nonetheless the old boy was cheery enough with me

"They tell me you ride motorbikes," the old boy said, chewing on a chunky sandwich. "I'll bet you didn't know there was motorbikes made here in Frinton. I was very surprised to hear this. Frinton seemed the last place on earth where motorcycles would be made "Ratcliffe - " - the old boy went on,- " - the Ratcliffe brothers. They made cars was well, and I worked for them. We even went to Brooklands a few times. It all packed up when the War started...."

"Oh," I said wondering if this was a fairy tale "So they made bikes until 1939?" "No" he snorted in some derision. "- I mean the First War – the Great War, the one that started in 1914." He then carried on giving me an account of these machines which he worked on as a young man. It seemed there was indeed a factory of a humble type in Frinton, which firstly made bicycles at the beginning of the twentieth-century and then developed into the new motorised technology. There were in those early days, many small manufacturers of motorcycles – most destined to fail.

"Belt drive — " he went on, " — not so good if it were wet, chains were better - they didn't slip." At that precise moment, another man - well dressed - was passing by and then stopped. "Belts on motorbikes? — I don't know how many times I had to mend them on my old Premier I had a sidecar and that added to the load After the War, I got a Triumph" I assumed by his evident age he was also talking of the First World War. " A trusty Triumph.." he added with a flourish. His remark was loud enough to be heard by a lady and gentleman walking arm-in-arm, on the other side of the road.. "Trusty Triumphs?" the gent called across, "-I rode them for thousands of miles in Mespotamia (nowadays Iraq) during the War " The couple came over to join us and immediately there was a whole series of yarns being swopped about motorcycling before, during and after the First World War. with me as a very attentive bystander though I wished I had a tape recorder.

Two things struck me at the time. Frinton seemed entirely populated by the elderly - and secondly; it is surprising who – no matter how genteel and distinguished they become in later life – how people remembered and enjoyed their youthful experiences on motorbikes.

A final thought stikes me today - I am now as elderly as that group of old-timers were then....
