David Smith and myself recently attended a planning meeting at Snetterton and we will be talking to various clubs and disciplines to provide machinery/personnel for both static and active displays or demonstrations. It's a great opportunity that will allow us to show off our sports to an anticipated audience in excess of 2,000 people.

On a personal note, I was sad to see that Kath Avery passed away recently. Without doubt one of the longest standing and most loyal Halstead Club members who put a lot of time and effort into running the club's events. She was always busy with her various organising hats, but always had time for a chat and a kindly word – she will be greatly missed.



The Recollection Section

Much to my shame, I have to admit that in all my years of trials riding and involvement with the sport, I have never journeyed north to attend the Scottish Six Day Trial. It is an omission I would like to correct in the future. I did however, cross the water to the T.T.



races for many years and during the 1960's,probably witnessed the most intriguing technical developments in virtually all classes of races as the Japanese companies increasingly made their presence felt.

Both these events began over a hundred years ago and therefore in motor sport terms, both are highly regarded fixtures on the sporting calendar. Both were initially instituted as mainly testing and reliability competitions for the very early form of automobiles and – in effect – powered bicycles. Both competitions have evolved and aided evolution in motorcycle design over the century of their duration and inevitably today's motorcycles bear scant comparison to their beginnings. That is of course, exactly as it should be – if we made no progress in a hundred years, what would be the point? So the question might properly be put: "Which event has brought the greatest technological improvement?" – or rather, "Which discipline has developed the most: trials or road racing?"

If I think of the span of my own time - mainly in trials, in my early days, I did compete in a few higher level events such as, "Nationals" without being altogether too futile at riding the sections which were then presented Not so today! Even in my earlier, more proficient, years, I would have never been able to get anywhere near the hazards which great stars such as, Dougie Lampkin, James Dahbill and Tony Bou nowadays tackle and conquer, Superb riders without doubt — but extraordinary machines as well, with such radical improvements in every sphere of their operation as to totally change the nature of the sport. We have seen truly tremendous forward development in trials bikes.

Yet in road-racing I'm not so sure. Development there has been certainly but if we take the T.T. as an example, the lap record stands today at a sizzling 132mph. However nearly sixty years ago, Bob Macintyre broke the "100mph barrier" four times in an eight- lap Senior T.T. race - on a machine of half the current superbike capacity, shod with skinny tyres (which did not need changing) and on roads which were nothing like as race -friendly as the T.T. circuit is today. Of course I understand that in any form of racing and records, we have to deal with the law of ,"diminishing returns". Therefore It gets increasingly difficult to improve. The power of current bikes render them a good fifty miles an hour faster than the machines of the 1950's - which does bring in its wake, other issues. To that extent the greatest improvement must be in the ability for them to handle, stop and steer as well as they do on the non-forgiving 37 mile circuit. Nonetheless I go back to my original point: In my opinion, the greatest improvement overall is with the trials bikes (and thereby trials riding) and that is reason why I would like to visit the spectacle of the Six Days Trial.






