Foreword Phil Armes

I feel a little bit like a stuck record as once again we have seen riders illegally charging through parts of Thetford Forest and putting the running of future events in jeapody. However, as you will see from the picture below, the Police are now taking a much tougher stance, and in addition to issuing

Section 59 notices they have confiscated two bikes – hopefully they will follow this up and crush them. Might sound a bit harsh, but it could be the only way that the message will finally get through to the mindless few who are spoiling everyone else's fun.

As all organisers will know the cost of medical services at events has risen sharply in recent years and the delivery of the medical services has attracted a much sharper focus – especially in the area of ambulance provision. With the never ending pressure on county ambulance services some trusts are becoming increasingly reticent to attend sporting events, not just motorcycle events, for what they see as 'minor' injuries. And whilst they do have a duty of care, they may not respond for some considerable time, up to several hours, to take an injured person to hospital. Therefore event organisers should ensure they have the right level of cover at their meetings to allow the event to continue to run if a rider needs to be taken to hospital and an ambulance has to leave the venue. And most importantly organisers need to check that their medical service provider has CQC

registration for it's vehicles which is a legal requirement for them to be able to take

people to hospital.

You will see later in this issue a short note about a new autobiography that has been written by Ken Davis. Many of you will know Ken, but for those of you who don't, he has been an active member of the Centre (and at events throughout the UK) for many years attending and officiating in various capacities across all the disciplines – and he previously held the editors chair of the gazette. I'm sure it will be a fascinating read and probably an insight into the changes and developments of our sport over the years, so take a look at the info and find out how to get your copy.

And finally, the Woodbridge club will be holding a round of the Maxxis British Motocross Championship in a little over a month's time so I'm sure the club would appreciate your support with venue preparation, or of course as a spectator on the day.

Mark's Progress


Sidge Kenny

We should all congratulate Mark who has now emerged from South America, where at Tijuana, he crossed the border into the United States. From our standpoint we might assume the most potentially hazardous section of his vast journey is over, I must emphasise that Mark has

always stressed the upbeat side of his travels but he was clearly relieved to have made the transit from Colombia and along the Isthmus to the south of Mexico. His world-wide journeys have certainly helped my geography as I had no idea just how vast Mexico is , as it stretches up to the USA. Mark took much of April travelling through this fascinating country and made his crossing to the USA in early May. The Mexican stage started from San Cristobal de la Casa to the Gulf (east side) and up to Vera Cruz Then on to Mexico City which he thoroughly enjoyed for its energy - though he had time to take in some of the Aztec culture. Journeying up to Tequila, he made sharp comment on the many speed bumps en-route before arriving at Mazatlan on the west side, where he made the sea crossing to the Baja peninsula, alighting at La Paz. Right at the most southerly tip on the Pacific coast at Cabo San Lucas, the harbour is evidently a prime area

for luxurious yachts – Mark doubted any were worth less than a million dollars! Another 300 miles got him to Loreto, this time over on the edge of the Gulf of California. Further north to Tijuana and the crossing where he was aided by a fellow biker who saved him a possible loss of 400 dollars. It seems this leg of the journey has been very enjoyable for Mark with the places he has seen and the people he has met. But poor old Bertha, his faithful BMW, had to have another set of front wheel and steering head bearings, plus a fork seal. - It must have been the speed bumps!



Recollection Section

Sidge Kenny

My initial reaction to the recent announcement that the ACU had fully aligned itself with LARA. (Land Access Recreation Association, was to say out loud: "About bl—dy time...".



I do not know the background but my guess is that our current ACU chairman: John Collins has a greater appreciation of the politically (small "p") vulnerable position of virtually all the aspects of our sport, than perhaps his two immediate predecessors. It also might be a reaction to the current clampdown by Powys County Council in Wales, on the ability of off-roaders to use some of the "green lanes" - which I always thought had full vehicular rights in law. In that particular location, such an imposition would be a very damaging factor when organising enduro events but equally trials, where lanes may well be required for access to particular sections. In many cases, these locations might have already been used by clubs, literally for decades.

Every contestant in each of the off-road disciplines should get it put deeply into his helmet that there are very real and potentially powerful forces who consider we have no place in the countryside and these forces are getting stronger. The green movement – which I must admit I do have some support for some of their aims – may not be very strong in stark political terms but they do have a great deal of influence on Governments and Councils. As a lobbying group, The Ramblers Association has long been a major objector to much of motorcycle sport activities in the countryside – indeed one of their founding creeds goes along the lines of:- "motor vehicles have no place in the countryside." It is therefore obvious that in order to at least have some form of fair play, we need to harness a defence to this type of: "sweep `em all away" attitude and this is what LARA is set up to do.

I recall Ralph Venables, that long remembered motorcycle journalist and organiser, putting up many a stout upholding of our rights, back in the 1950's and 60's. A very doughty figure who wrote and spoke equally well, he was strongly of the view that it paid to liaise with the authorities and landowners to get to an understanding by them that any event held by our clubs would be a properly organised and controlled sporting function and not a bunch of rabble-rousers out to tear up the greenery or disturb the wildlife. This entailed early preparation and contact with the people involved "face-to-face", being preferable with the farmers and landowners and not least, grateful acknowledgement to all parties after the meeting was over. No doubt many clubs and organisers do this already – the Castle Club being one example. This of course, all helps in individual cases but ultimately it is legislation which will eventually call the overall tune of whether we have motorised access to the countryside.

Many of us will recall the ACU being jointly involved in the "Motorsports Facility Unit" which had its office at Rugby, under Dave Kersey, who worked with many recognised organisations including the then Sports Council and LARA itself. Dave had a road accident which curtailed his career and the ACU for whatever reason, did not carry on with the MFU. It most certainly left a gap and it is therefore all the more heartening to see this closer union with LARA to more effectively fight our corner.
