

Recollection Section

As we trundle into a New Year, some of us from the older end might be thinking to ourselves:- "I never thought we would make it to now" - or perhaps it is just me.



I've been in motorcycle sport for a long while and along the way there have been issues which did seem to present a real challenge to its continuation. I am speaking nationally here, where perhaps all of motorcycle sport might have been under threat. Putting aside out-of-the-blue disasters such as foot and mouth disease, on looking back, we seem to have evaded – or is it avoided? - being seriously jumped on. It appears the only adverse force which has actually stopped our wheels rolling on Sundays for any length of time, has been war .

So where are – or were – the worries? The first I recall, was way back in the 1950's when Britain was a different country to now, with the actions of the: "Lords Day Observation Society", which sought to enforce the very stolid laws of the old-style Sunday's. Most shops shut, no cinemas running top feature films, or major league football matches and for us - no money to be taken from the public, which affected race meetings, particularly scrambles and grass track events. Indeed one of the most prestigious scramble meetings of the time: The Shrubland Park National, sponsored by the Daily Herald, was investigated by the police before permission was granted to allow the meeting to proceed. For some obscure reason, clubs were able to charge for car parking and programmes and thereby they could redeem their necessary costs. Of course we all know Sundays are very different nowadays and after many legal alterations, we have: "24/7"

Right on the heels of the L.D.O.S. came the "Noise Abatement Society" - which of course had our activities well in its sights. To a degree, their objectives were granted the power of law and today noise enforcement is monitored and controlled by local authorities. We also acknowledged the problem – and no doubt about it – some bikes were excessively noisy to the extent that we introduced both our own noise limits and official noise (sound) controllers. While the internal combustion engine is with us, we probably will always have noise issues – though sometimes it is a meeting's P.A. System which causes the greatest complaint – but in the main, we operate without much bother.

The "Chesham Report" on trials and rallies of the late 1960's, was another worrying shot across our bows. I speak from memory but the main reason for this piece of legal re-working, under the auspices of Lord Chesham, was mainly because of the nuisance caused by car rallies to the residents of villages - particularly at night. To a degree, we of the motorcycle world were dragged in because of our affiliation with the RAC. I was never aware of any individual motorcycle event causing offence – though I cannot be sure at this distance. The result was nonetheless to impose a restriction to our events which embraced road work and accelerated the amount of multi- lap events – now almost universal - held entirely on private ground. Obviously, the other disciplines were not as affected as trials but it focused public attention in our direction and not in a good way. Bizarre indeed that to

run a trial with road work today, you have to get permission and pay for it – from the RAC.



Yet I am always impressed when reading the motorcycle press of just how many events take place all over the nation and with the highly active youth section it seems the sport will carry on and on for generations. Amen to that – and even when the oil runs out, we will still hopefully ride - on the electric bikes. The noise abatement folk would just love that - some of them might even come to watch.

Now is the time to renew your number for 2018. If you want to ensure you keep the same number for the 2018 season, you must renew after 30th November and by 31st January 2018 at the latest. NO NUMBERS WILL BE HELD AFTER THIS DATE.

Any numbers not renewed by 31st January will be made available on a first come, first served basis. If you have not renewed your number by this date there is every possibility that you could lose it to another rider. There were in the region of 700 numbers sold for 2017 so if you don't want to lose your number, renew it NOW.

You can renew your number online at www.easternacu.org or if you prefer by using the postal form on the opposite page.

The cost of reserving your number remains at £5 per season. If reserving the number online an extra 39p is added to cover the fees we are charged by PayPal. This ensures that the chosen charities (in 2016 they are East Anglian Air Ambulance, Essex Air Ambulance & ACU Benevolent Fund) do not lose out, and is still cheaper than sending the application form by post.

Numbers 1 – 50 are kept for experts only. Number 1 will be offered to the Centre Champion; in the event that the champion declines, number 1 will not be issued.

In the past 3 years this scheme has enabled the ACU Eastern, on behalf of riders, to make donations of more than £10,000 to the chosen charities.
