



### **Recollection Section**

Sidge Kenny

In the 1950's my parents took me on a holiday in the West country, which included a brief stay at Westonsuper-Mare. I recall we were impressed by the beach



- though I think we felt the one at Ilfracombe in neighbouring Devon, was better. Nowadays, Weston-super-Mare hosts one of the top events in the motorcycling calendar with its famous beach races and the town is a draw for thousands of bike fans. The event must be the biggest of its type but my memory tells me, the Isle of Man, at both Douglas and Peel, and at Jersey and Guernsey in the Channel Isles, had been running beach races many years earlier. I cannot claim to know any riders engaged in this branch of the sport - but I do recall our own Jack Hubbard, perhaps somewhat late in his career, swopped the scrambler's bumps and then the grass, to finally excel on the sand circuits when he resided in the Channel Islands.

The sport extends back many years and was really an extension of grass track racing with the circuit laid out on the appropriate sand base made flat by the tide. The Weston Beach race however ,in common with the other more testing events, has massive artificial dunes built up to increase the interest for spectators and most certainly to raise the challenge for the riders! Riding on sand is an art and you have to be super-fit to take on the sheer body-sapping effort of keeping upright on the rutted and shifting surface. Another factor to take in, is the wear and tear on the bike. Sand acts like grinding paste to exposed chains and sprockets and additionally it gets in everywhere else. Add the corrosive elements of salt water and you are most certainly in for a complete strip-down and clean-up after the meeting. To do well in a beach race therefore, you have to be sharp and tough with bags of stamina and your bike must be perfectly prepared. Nonetheless for many riders and spectators, the big beach races are meetings to be relished. Indeed, I was surprised at just how many coastal venues, all over the country this, perhaps lesser regarded sport takes place.

Which brings me back to the seaside towns and the fact that they actually foster these events on their precious beaches – albeit when the normal holidaymakers have gone home. There is no doubt their local economy is bolstered by the attendance of riders and spectators to a major beach race. I find it rather ironic that these folk of the "establishment" - who would probably like to hound us out of our countryside sporting venues for trials, grass track and motocross meetings - actively encourage the crowd-attracting beach races. Their views presumably being amended by the jingle of coin, or more correctly in this day and age, the rustle of the credit cards..

# Bickers Lifting ACU Eastern Solo Motocross Championships

The sixth round of the Bickers Lifting sponsored Eastern centre motocross championships, held at a well prepped Blaxhall circuit, saw all of the various champions crowned with the bubbly sprayed in abundance at the after race presentations. All six rounds were well supported by the riders, and it is increasingly apparent that our centre championships are the envy of many others.

At a superbly worked circuit at Wattisfield for round five, Jake Nicholls increased his lead in the series with three more race wins, although Shaun Southgate and Luke Benstead scored well to keep in contention. In the junior championships, it was Bill Moynes who took the overall win from new champion, Ryan Watts.

The Blaxhall round had more than its share of drama. Jake had set the fastest time in practise, but twisted his leg badly, resulting in a broken fibula and tibia. This meant that Shaun, despite riding against a few National grade riders, obtained enough points to clinch the 2018 title. He probably would not have wanted to win in this manner, but many congratulations to him for his consistency over the season. Jake was second, eleven points down on Shaun, with 2017 champion, Luke Benstead just six points behind Jake, in third place.

The impressive Ryan Watts deservedly took the junior title by a huge margin of 138 points clear of Connor Baldry in second place, with over 40's champion, Matt French in third place.

## ACU Eastern Enduro Championship Review - October 2018 Roger Chaplin

In a few days time the 7th and final round of the G H Motorcycles/Husqvarna/ ACU Eastern Enduro Championship with five of the six Classes to be decided.

The venue is Thetford Forest the Diss Motor Cycle Club's Muntjac Enduro which have come about because the organisers could not run a National round because of clashing with the ISDE.

I have a full set of official positions in each Class and after the 6th round at Butley, another cracking event organised by the Woodbridge Club there is still a lot to ride for despite some riders disappointments of losing victories due to punctured rear tyres, gaining penalty points on the last fast lap or having poor Special Tests times.

The supreme Title of ACU Eastern Enduro Champion (Championship Class) is virtually between current holder Jason Morland and Luke Parker with only two points separating them and really both need the win to clinch the Title although if both slip up and Will Hughes wins then the Title is his.

Jack Berry has led the Expert Class from round one and has 92 points however James Barker has chipped away and his fourth round win of the Contest at Butley puts him on 93 points one ahead of Berry. The Title is between these two and if Barker becomes the Class Champion he joins Lewis Bond and Alex Ramption as the only riders to win Clubman and Expert Titles in successive years. Another piece of history could be made by George Eustace who only needs three points then he would become the only rider to finished third in the Clubman & Expert Class in successive years.

In the Expert Veteran Class the battle is again between Michael Ridge 109 points and Gavin Hockey 104 points and you never know Hockey could have a penalty free last lap ride to take the

Title. Paul Spurgeon, Phil Roper and Damian Long are contenders for third place.

It is congratulations to Rob Aldridge the winner of the Clubman Class this year having won 5 of the 6 rounds this year only being beaten by a 15 year old at Hadham and Rob has told me he is very happy to ride in the Expert Class in 2019 as these up and coming youngsters are being a worry to him, Rob is only 26. The battle for second and third is between Dan Hunt and George Wolfe while Jake Roper the 15 year old I mentioned is not eligible to ride.

The most tightly contested Class every year is the Clubman Veteran with these five riders in a position to win the Title, Steve Youngs 71 points, Dean Curry 67 points, Michael Wyatt 64 points, Andy Peck 59 point and Jason Carsboult 58 points. The last round usually throws up a surprise so we will see.

Andy Mason is nearly there in the Clubman Super Veteran Class with 102 points and only Graham Mays on 84 points can overhaul him and Mays could lose out on a second or third place in the Contest from Gary Drage, Jez Moss, Nigel Ross and Gene Womack.
