Recollection Section

Sidge Kenny

Our chairman, Phil showed commendable foresight when he called a meeting in September to discuss "Sustainability" with regards to our sport and indeed the future of the Eastern Centre (Region) itself. The main issues which came out of this meeting were: a lack of younger people coming in to take on the organisation and administration of the sport, the reducing number of accessible sites with suitable land for the various types of events the Centre currently runs and the effects of local authorities and their demands over public and environmental safety.

In short, the need is for more people to get involved with running of things at Centre level and during the debate, Phil raised the query: "Is a Centre necessary at all in these times?" No motions were put before the delegates and all went away, to discuss these topics within their respective clubs and perhaps produce some ideas or even volunteers to fill the position vacancies – not the least being that of Centre Secretary - as our redoubtable Lyn has given notice that she is to retire next year.

How did things get to a need for such a meeting? As archivist, I can see how the Centre and indeed the sport itself has fundamentally changed over the decades. Perhaps the most telling clues are in the pages of this very journal - our Eastern Centre Gazette If I open a copy of seventy years ago, admittedly a long time ago, the Centre, already thirty years in existence, was picking itself up after the six-year shutdown due to World War 11. Looking through the report of 1950, I see that the Centre then comprised of 36 clubs and ran 121 permitted events – not so very different from the pre-Covid tally of recent years and moreover at a time when petrol was rationed after the War. Additionally, there was no junior sport in those days. What is different is the copious reports in the Gazette of club activities, and this shows that the majority of motorcycle clubs had many functions going on besides sporting events. There would be road runs out to various destinations, sometimes in support of their riders at sporting events, dart matches, dances, dinners, quizzes and treasure hunts. All taking in club members of both sexes and which the majority were not competitors in any sporting discipline at all. It was simply the enthusiasm for riding motorbikes and enjoying "club life" of great variety. The social scene obviously attracted active young people, both men and women. Probably many a marriage was put on the launch pad at the local motorcycle club. Yet every member of a Centre club would (or should!) have been an affiliated member of the ACU by virtue of their club subscription. Therefore, the sheer numbers would have easily exceeded our current strength and also filled the

ACU coffers. It is plain to see that there was a real pride in their club and a great willingness to get involved and stuck in whenever a club staged any event, sporting or otherwise. The word: "enthusiasm," simply wafts off the yellowing pages of these old copies.



Not that I am critical of today's clubs. They do their best in a difficult environment. These are totally different times and for enthusiastic young people, there are so many more outlets for their leisure-time. Added to that, there are indisputably more pressures to confine and reduce our sport, both directly and indirectly. Another factor is that we in the Eastern Centre are within one of the more populated areas in the country which can make our sporting activities even more vulnerable. Proof of that is in the high loss of sporting venues Essex itself has suffered over those long years from the 1950's.On the whole however, whilst we might not be seeing a red light nowadays, it is looking increasingly amber.



The final round of the 2021 Eastern Centre Motocross Championships, sponsored by Instanda and Stebbings Car Superstore, was held at Lyng on Sunday 10th October. Hosted by the Norwich Vikings club, the Cadders Hill circuit was in prime condition, and a bumper entry of 200 riders competed at the iconic hillside track.

After the timed qualification sessions, the fastest 40 riders competed in the premier class, with the remaining competitors separated into four support groups.





Current champion, Suffolk's Lewis Tombs, came to Lvng with a 24 points advantage over Norfolk ace, Parker, in the experts' class. but with 75 points up for grabs, everything was to be decided on the day. Race one saw Tombs leading. chased hard by Parker throughout the twenty minute long race. Kings Lynn's Calum Mitchell was pushing hard in third place, followed closely by former champion, Benstead. Luke

Newmarket youngster, Sam Nunn. At the finish, Tombs took the win, with Parker only yards behind. A mistake by Mitchell had dropped him to fifth place, with Benstead crossing the finish line in third, just ahead of Nunn. Tom Murphy rounded out the top six.





With the junior grade riders scoring separately, series leader, Callum Murfitt, increased his championship lead. The seventeen-year-old was the leading junior rider, finishing in 11th place, therefore collecting maximum points in his class. His nearest rival. Gardiner, had earlier had machine problems, which effectively meant that the junior title was settled after the first race. Chelmsford teenager, Bennett, was the second junior to finish in 13th place, just ahead of the young Norfolk ace, Bayliss Utting.

Race two of the premier group saw local ace, Parker, charging to the front on his Kawasaki, this time Tombs was the chaser, and the crowd witnessed some very fast close racing at the front. Tombs made his move on lap six to take over the lead, and despite a strong challenge from Parker, held on to record his second win. Behind them, Benstead held third place for ten laps,

until Tom Grimshaw made a strong pass with two laps remaining. Ben Cole and Sam Nunn were involved in a battle for fifth place, with Nunn getting the verdict at the finish. Murphy rode consistently again to take 7th, with Todd Ritchie just behind him.

Murfitt was again the leading junior grade rider in a fine 10th place, after a closely fought battle with Bennett. Ben Gillett rode well for third best junior, just ahead of two more up and coming youngsters, Thomas Harris and Jake Rackham.

The third premier class race saw Parker taking victory, leading each lap. Tombs held second place, content in the knowledge that he had held on to his title, and Grimshaw held off his under 21 British team mate, Sam Nunn, for third place. Mitchell was fifth, chased by Tom Murphy. Murfitt celebrated his junior title win with a fine 9th place, with Adam Reeve next best junior in 11th, followed by Harris and Rackham in 12th and 13th places.



The supporting A group saw overall victory going to lady rider, Kathryn Booth, who was second in the first two moto's, and made sure of the overall by winning the third race. Local rider, Robert Baldry won the first race, followed by a 4th and 3rd place to claim second on the day, with Joshua Deadman putting in three good rides for third overall.

Charlie Dormer won the first two races in the B group, but struggled in his third race for third overall. Consistent riding from Bailey Jackson, and veteran Steve Atkins saw them 1st and 2nd on the day.

In the C supporting group, Nathan Moulton won all three moto's, chased home each time by fellow Norfolk rider, Scott Goodson. Ty Atkins was third each time, for 3rd overall, and three wins by Andrew Webster in the D group saw him easily the overall winner.
