11th September saw the Sudbury club host the final round of the ACU Eastern 2 Man Enduro Championship at Pebmarsh, sponsored by Dave Barkshire Motorcycles.

A damp misty morning following heavy rain greeted the sombre riders briefing as Roger Chaplin the President of Sudbury MCC paid tribute to the Late Queen Elizabeth II before a 2 minutes silence.



This last event in the Dave Barkshire championship series concludes a difficult summer with events being cancelled or postponed due to fire risk and excessive dust, with final places being decided.

The previous day's downpours created perfect going and presented enough challenges for the most experienced rider as they tackled changes of terrain, ditches, bridges, bogs, logs and stubble with long fast straights for each riders 4 half hour timed sessions. With a few mechanical issues troubling a number of partnerships it made for challenging handovers and time was key to getting the laps in and clocking up as few penalties as possible.

With the course reversed for the afternoon sessions and a special test for the first rider out the beautiful hot autumn afternoon guaranteed some keen sport for the good turnout of supportive spectators to enjoy.

Recollection Section

Sidge Kenny



Over the last few weeks the nation's attention has been rightly turned to the sad loss of our Queen, who, no one could ever deny, served her country as she promised, right to the very end. She loved racing – not our kind but of the four-legged variety and yet a similar excitement and enthusiasm is contained within that sport as it is in ours. She served in an Army motor pool during the War, so she knew all about spark plugs, brake linings and the like. Some have said that she never seemed quite the same after the loss of her husband and almost lifelong partner, Prince Philip. In our sport, we must not forget that he, besides being a Patron of the ACU, also visited the T.T. Races more than once. I had a lot of time for them both, not only by reputation but in the case of Prince Philip, from seeing him in action and close up. Moreover it was at an Eastern Centre location.

It was in October 2002, that I received an official invitation as Chairman of the Centre to attend to the opening of a motocross practice track near to Kings Lynn – “Super Trax”. It was not quite the usual set up of such a facility of which we have had several in the Centre over the years. It seems this one was also greatly supported by the local council as evidently part of an exercise to promote sport for youth in that area. What ever it was, there was a big turnout of Councillors and local dignitaries added by our own Centre officials, led by Andy Crawford, who was “Mr Motocross” for the Centre at that time. The venue was on former farmland and as anyone who knows that region just south of the Wash, the land is very flat. It would not be untrue to say that the circuit, which also featured an area for karts, was very much artificially made up for motocross - but for the purpose of practice and training, was perfectly adequate. As I recall it, it was some time into the official proceedings that word went around that Prince Philip was due to appear. He did so in quite a spectacular manner, arriving in a black, dark-glassed and very solid-looking Range Rover, emerging with a smile and accompanied by his equally solid-looking body guards. The assembled councillors and their assistants came forward to give him the formal welcome and introduced those who were connected with the project and described its purpose. There was a slight rather unsure pause when the Prince then asked to see some more of the circuit – jumps and all. Technical knowledge of the sport itself was clearly needed - and quickly. Here, Andy Crawford stepped forward and in a little group, he took the Prince around. Duly completed, there was another pause as Prince Philip was then asked to give out the prizes for a youth motocross held at Gt Hockham the previous day. I rather suspected the Prince might have not have been aware of this extra item for his attention but nonetheless and with a smile, he took to handing out to the assembled young victors their awards and trophies. Of course, they were now dressed normally – with just a few being perhaps somewhat casual for this special occasion. None seemed at all overwhelmed by who was giving out their awards. And then with another smile and a wave, and accompanied by our grateful cheers, he climbed back into the chunky Range Rover in concert with his equally chunky minders and sped off – presumably back to Sandringham.

I was very impressed. Impressed that we have a monarchy which can intersperse with such ease with its people. I hope it will continue so for a very long time.

Those prize winners would have grown up now – some will still be riding and some still winning awards and trophies. But I rather hope they will give that particular cup or shield an extra polish – the one that was handed to them by royalty – Prince Philip himself.
