

The trial was attended by many from Club members, families, officials from other clubs and Centre ACU Officials along with a high number of youth competitors riding electric trials bikes.

Castle Flags and banners welcomed competitors, giving that wow factor

The youth's riding was excellent to watch with some awesome rides throughout the day. Well done to them all.

Certificates were given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd positions in each class and route. Finally, all competitors received a finishers award/treat.

# Recollection Section

Sidge Kenny

There can be no doubt that Alan Millyard has machined himself into a unique position in the motorcycle world. His fame as the amazing engineer of beautifully turned out, "Specials," now amplified with his appearances with the ever-mystified, Henry Coles, on on the popular TV motorbike shows, has brought his unique handiwork work to millions – many probably quite unaware of the ingenuity, hard work and sheer artistry which has gone into his mobile masterpieces.

I was lucky enough to see two of Alan's examples perform at Sammy Millers motorcycle museum, a couple of years ago. Miller has a large open yard to the rear of the museum building and on this occasion – the opening of an extra wing – several of the most prestigious bikes were parked outside. Amongst one of these appeared to be a genuine 1960's Honda six-cylinder works racer! It was immaculate. Some time during the proceedings, Alan started it up. Oh my lord! Fingers in your earholes – but it was music nonetheless. Alan – who I still did not know was the builder of this incredible replica duly did a few raucous bottom gear laps. Having seen the originals all those years ago, race at the TT - when he stopped and cut the engine, I nearly knelt down in homage. Yet more was to come.

A most unweildy looking yet beautifully turned-out decidedly American-looking bike, was standing near by. It had a very BIG vee-twin engine. Written on the tank was: "Millyard Special" - at the time, I took it to be a rare American make, perhaps based on an early Indian. Alan then started it up and again circulated. What a difference to the screaming high-revving Honda! It seemed he circulated a whole lap of the run-round in a couple of deep-throated: "Boom-Booms". The bike clearly had the torque of a Caterpillar tractor. Alan rode it as cleanly as he had circulated with the Honda. When he stopped, I still did not know that he again, was that unique bike's constructor – or that the engine was composed of two cylinders taken from a monster nine-cylinder Pratt and Whitney aircraft engine! I merely went over and complimented him on his riding. Now I know the

facts – I can only say the man is a genius and must rate as motorcycling's: 'Michael Angelo' - such is the splendour of his products.

Throughout motorcycle history, people have made "specials". It does reflect, I think, on the type of person who is a motorcyclist. Often, he (or she) sees further – and wishes to improve. He has - sometimes - the ability to engineer it. Sometimes it works – sometimes it doesn't... He tries anyway. I can think of many such people from, John Catchpole and his trials solos and chairs, to the



largely forgotten Fred Marsh, who did also produce a four cylinder racer, using some Triumph Tiger Cub internals. Reg Geeson, Chris Tattersall, – Eric Cheyney, and surely there are many more who I have overlooked. Closer to home, I must mention Graham Braybrooke, John Daly, and others who produce such interesting and well-performing trials bikes in our own `Classic` class.

What I think elevates Alan Millyard's products, is the almost outrageous nature of what he sets out to do. A Honda Six racer? Who would have thought it possible? He did. A huge six- litre vee twin? Again, why not? It has to be acknowledged that Alan has risen the recognition of special building to new heights. I have used the word "artistry" - it would not be far wrong.


He has lifted the whole special-building scene in a similar range as those from the early crude representations in cave painting - to all the flamboyance, colour - and popularity of a Walt Disney film. Where will his imagination lead him next? – we all await....

# **ACU Eastern GH MC's Solo Enduro R4**

The soft ground over grass gave a varied and interesting course over farmland and through several wooded sections with an optional bog which many choose to avoid. To make the event more challenging: ever decreasing allotted times were given to the 4,5 or 6 sessions the six different classes rode with little time for rest or refuelling for any riders not pushing for the fastest time every lap out on the course. This multi lap timecard event tested the maths skills of even the most experienced competitors as fractions of a lap were given in penalties for coming in late. Competitors admitted how tight the timing proved to be and looked visibly spent as they entered the pits for the final time following the chequered flag.

After 4 rounds positions for the Solo Championship are 1st Ben Clarke Braintree 66 points, 2nd Luke Parker Norwich 57 points, 3rd Jamie Roper Sudbury 35 points also 3rd Will Hughes Braintree 35 points and 5th Jake Roper 30 points.
