Trials Committee Notes *Clive Dopson*

Notes from ACU Eastern Trials Committee Call March 2nd 2023

On March 2nd the Eastern Centre Trials Committee had its first call of the year. These notes do not cover all the discussions, the other subjects are in the complete call minutes issued in the normal way.

- Starting in 2023, as agreed at the 2022 Trials Forum, the ACU-EC Youth Trials championship will move to B
 Class championship rounds, Youth Expert on Red/Blue route, Youth Intermediate on the 50/50 route and
 Youth Novice on White route. This allows all youth riders to select whichever route, and therefore the section
 severity, they wish to ride, it is the responsibility of the youth rider's parent or guardian at the event to ensure
 the rider is capable of riding the route selected.
- 2. With regard to trials rider grading within ACU-EC
 - a. Movement between A and B grade is at the rider's choice, but in a calendar year if a rider scores points at A level, they cannot subsequently score at B level in the same year.
 - b. For each year the Intermediate A champion is promoted to Expert starting in the following year.
 - c. For each year the Novice champion is promoted to Intermediate starting in the following year, also any Novice who wins three or more Best Novice awards in a year in trials above closed to club with 5 or more novice riders will also be promoted to Intermediate.
 - d. Any rider can inform the trials committee they want to self-promote to the next grade, this can be done at any time by informing the Trials Committee at dopson_boar@msn.com.
 - e. Any Expert rider can request to be demoted to Intermediate by asking the Trials Committee, this can happen on an annual basis, any applications for demotion in 2024 to be made before July 1st 2023 to the Trials Committee at dopson_boar@msn.com.
 - f. Any Expert who is demoted cannot score Intermediate ACU-EC championship points, club championship points or win Intermediate awards for two years, for example for any rider demoted for 2024 this will apply for 2024 and 2025.
- 3. Clerks of Course are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure all requirements of the TSRs are met.
- 4. It was agreed that the Trials Committee and Comps Committee will work together to support any requests to encourage Youth only trials, e.g., by reducing costs or simplifying event organisation.
- Clubs are reminded of the decision from the 2022 Trials Forum, to start in 2023 for ACU-EC Trials Championship rounds, one number to be fitted on the front of the machine and one fitted to the rear of the rider's helmet.
- Clubs are requested to supply any reports of trials for the gazette and/or the website, all contributions will be appreciated, especially those with photographs.

Noted since the call,

A, the Trials Committee were approached to clarify the observing rules for the ACU-EC Pre 70 Trials Championship for the benefit of officials, observers and riders.

According to the current ACU-EC Trials Conditions, ACU-EC Pre 70 Trials Championship rounds are run to the current ACU NON-STOP rules, a failure (or 5) is considered to have occurred if (amongst other reasons), the machine ceases to move in a forward direction. Although this does not penalise the hopping of front, rear of both wheels it does mean if hopping occurs whilst the machine is not travelling in the direction of the section then this should be scored as a 5.

B Riders should be made aware or reminded of the following rules in the ACU National Sporting Code

NSC article 11.01.6 specifies that "any proceeding or act prejudicial to the interests of, any part or body of the ACU, or of the sport of motorcycling generally" is an offence that may be subject to disciplinary action. NSC article 11.01.8 specifies "The use of Social Media to propagate foul, abusive or offensive language, profane activity or fraudulent comments against any Rider, Official or member of the ACU (including its affiliated Centres/Clubs/Promoters) or deemed to bring the ACU into disrepute by any accessible Social Media outlet (eg. Facebook, Twitter, Blogs, Texts, Webshots, Instagrams, Public Forums) or any other Social Network sites is not permitted"

Recollection Section

Early this month of May, the greater majority of the population, will have been absorbed by the ceremony and festivities surrounding the coronation of King Charles the Third. While we in the Eastern Centre have made no special plans for an event or special celebration - the King himself, having evidently sought a more 'economic'

Coronation from that granted to his mother seventy years ago. Accordingly, I thought I would just look in the archives to see how – if at all - we recognised that great national event of 1953. Step forward the excellent Southend

Motorcycle Club! On the Saturday after the Coronation, June 8th, , they ran the titled: "Coronation Scramble," in aid of the Benfleet Coronation Fund and held at the quaintly named: "Salvation Army Colony" fields at Hadleigh, Essex. This was open to all clubs in the Centre and the description of the course was given in the regulations as: "...rough, undulating grassland and is of a safe but fast nature. The course will be clearly marked and any short-cutting (!) will entail disqualification."

I feel that description was somewhat modest, since I was lucky enough to ride this circuit a decade later at their popular Whit Monday meetings and I felt it was one of the most varied and interesting scramble tracks in the Centre. Ridden as found – no 'technicalities' added. By my time of my competing there were most decidedly ropes in abundance to completely eliminate any chance of "course cutting..."

In these days of higher pressure and neo-professionalism within the sport of motocross, it is interesting to note the financial details. Prize money was divided amongst the three capacity classes

(250cc -350cc -500cc) - with an added: "handicap unlimited" final. For each of the bigger classes, the winner would receive 100 shillings (£5:00) with steps of payment made down to fifth place, 10/- (50p) Heat winners were to be paid at 10/- a win. Pretty good rewards for time where I would guess the average wage would be £10:00 – or less. The actual entry cost for this meeting is well worthy of note:- 7/6d! (35p) Which is light years away from today's financial commitment to a meeting by competitors. I wonder how all that compares with equivalent events today. I imagine most of today's motocross riders are substantially out of pocket if they are not supported or sponsored.

The Southend regulations also stipulated that machines must have two working brakes and a self-closing throttle – this last being a comparative recent ruling at the time and I suspect, based on speedway requirements. The starts were also of an older – almost quaint - variety, though to an extent, they offered greater interest for the spectators and tested both the riders athletic ability and their bike's ability to start. Standing ten yards behind the machine riders were faced with a; "dead engine start" to get going – though one, "pusher" per rider was allowed!

Sixty three riders were on the 10 race programme and included some top men of the time. Principal amongst these was the wellremembered Jack Hubbard on his two Matchless machines, as well as Keith Potter, similarly mounted. Of that number, I can only recognise one rider still with us today: staunch Ipswich Triangle man, Tony Crouch, riding a DOT. Together with fourteen riders representing the Southend club itself, there were riders from clubs no longer in existence, such as Planet, Briggs MCC, Tigers (Grays) and Hornchurch and District MCC. And - very interesting since their factory was only down the road, a solitary Greeves machine - ridden by Frank Byford. Could this have been one of their debut outings into the Sport? If so, we can only count it as a shame there are no Greeves "works" bikes - or indeed any Greeves works at all around for this later Coronation year...









