1. MEETINGS

The competition will be held over 4 youth meetings selected by the ACU Eastern Motocross Committee.

2. PERMIT

ACU Eastern Youth Championship meetings must be run under an Open Permit. A restricted to club permit is not acceptable.

3. TITLE

Each meeting shall be titled the

"ACU Eastern Youth Motocross Championship (Year) Round No...."

(To appear on documents & social media advertising)

4. ELECTRONIC TIMING

The timing of all ACU Eastern Championship meetings will be undertaken by an ACU approved Timing Operator using My laps/AMB electronic timing systems.

** Should electronic timing not be available for any reason, manual lap scoring will determine the results.

5. TRANSPONDERS (Solo Championship)

All machines must have a MYLAPS/AMB Motocross Transponder.

6. CLASSES

There will be five classes:

(1) Auto (2) 65cc (3) S/W 85cc (4) B/W 85cc (5) Open (youth)

7. ENTRIES / ELIGIBILITY

All riders entering an ACU Eastern Championship round will be taking part in the Championship. All points scored will count towards the relevant ACU Eastern Youth Motocross Championship

If requested by an organising club, or if they consider it appropriate in the best interests of the sport, the Eastern Centre Competitions Committee may, at their discretion, declare any rider ineligible to compete in any Centre Championship event (of any discipline) where the rider has been the subject of a formal disciplinary enquiry by any part of the ACU and had their competition licence withdrawn for a period of at least six months and/or fined more than £500 .

8. RACES

All races (legs) of a Championship meeting count towards the Championship.

The duration of each race is to be as follows: (minimum 5 riders)

1) Auto 6 mins + 1 lap 2) 65cc 9 mins + 1 lap 3) S/W 85cc 10 mins + 1 lap 4) B/W 85cc 12 mins + 1 lap 5) Open (youth) 14 mins + 1 lap

9. START

The start must be of a live engine clutch type.

10. POINTS

Points will be awarded for each race.

Points are awarded on the following scale: -

1st - 45 points, 2nd - 42 points, 3rd - 40 points, 4th -38 points, 5th - 36 points, 6th - 35 points and then reducing by one point per position until 40th - 1 point.

11. RESULTS

The rider gaining the most points from all 4 rounds will be declared the "ACU Eastern Youth Motocross Champion (Class)."

12. TIES

In the event of a tie on the total number of points scored the individual Champion will be decided in favour of the rider gaining the greatest number of first places, failing which the greater number of second places and so on. In the event of a tie still existing, then the rider who gains the highest position in the last race.

13. RECORDING OF RESULTS

It is the responsibility of each club organising a Championship meeting to Send, within 7 days of the event, a completed set of official results to: -

- 1) The Youth Motocross Championship Recorder via the MX Committee.
- 2) The Steward of the Meeting (if appointed)

Each organiser must include in their programme the current positions of the Championship Class which are being held at the meeting, details of which will be available from the Youth Championship Recorder, via the MX Committee.

14. AWARDS

The award will be the "Triangle (Ipswich) MCC Trophy" for the ACU Eastern Youth Motocross Championship......Class Trophies will be awarded for the following classes: -

- 1) Auto
- 2) 65cc
- 3) S/W 85cc
- 4) B/W 85cc
- 5) Open (youth)

Should any Champion not be resident within the ACU Eastern boundaries, the trophy will be engraved with the name of the champion and presented to the winner together with a replica for permanent keepsake. However, the named trophy will be returned immediately that evening to the Centre for safe keeping as it will not be permitted to leave the ACU Eastern boundary.

Only the winner of each class will receive a Centre Trophy and a replica.

All other placing trophies will be funded by participating Clubs.

NB The ACU Eastern boundaries are: Norfolk, Suffolk, Essex and that pert of Greater London situated north of the River Thames and east of the River Lea.

15. The decision of the ACU Eastern Competitions Committee on all matters relating to these Championship competitions shall be final.
